December 5, 2022

Council member Stoeffler introduced and moved the approval of RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING A TAXABLE GENERAL OBLIGATION REAL ESTATE INSTALMENT CONTRACT AND PRVIDING FOR THE LEVY OF TAXES TO PAY THE SAME. Council member Adams seconded the motion and it passed all ayes with record vote as follows: Ayes, Stoeffler, Vaughn, Adams, Geisinger, King. Nays: none. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the resolution was adopted and he gave it 22-12-1 for the record.

Council member Geisinger introduced and moved the approval of RESOLUTION WAIVING THE RIGHT OF REVIEW OF BOUNDARY ADJUSTMENT OF THE LOUSNBERRY ADDITION. Council member Vaughn seconded the motion and it passed all ayes with record vote as follows: Ayes, Stoeffler, Vaughn, Adams, Geisinger, King. Nays: none. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the resolution was adopted and he gave it 22-12-2 for the record.

Council member Adams introduced and moved the approval of RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING AND REGULATING RATES TO BE CHARGED FOR THE SALE OF WATER. Council member Vaughn seconded the motion and it passed all ayes with record vote as follows: Ayes, Stoeffler, Vaughn, Adams, Geisinger, King. Nays: none. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the resolution was adopted and he gave it 22-12-3 for the record.

Council member moved to approve sewer cleaning and cameraing contract with Central Iowa Televising.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, Council member Vaughn moved to adjourn. Council member Geisinger seconded the motion. The motion carried and the meeting adjourned.
