Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the resolution was adopted and he gave it 25-5-1 for the record.

Council member Stoeffler moved to approve Bruce Clatt, Craig Robinson, and Kim Hiedemann to the Colo Development Group. Council member Nicholas seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Council member Stoeffler moved to approve the liquor license for Niland's Café. Council member Vaugh seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Vicious dogs were discussed. More information is being gathered.

The Reed/Niland corner was discussed more information is being gathered on the new nonprofit.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, Council member Nicholas moved to adjourn. Council member Vaughn seconded the motion. The motion carried and the meeting adjourned.
